

### LESSON TITLE

RECORDING!

### OBJECTIVES

- Capture the voices of students about issues that matter to them.
- Reflect on what they learned from this program.
- Generate ideas for how to engage in philanthropy and service in the future.

### PREPARATION

- Gather nametags
- Ensure slides work. Pay special attention to the Service Learning slide and what suggestions you might have.
- Make copies of the survey, bring pens.
- Figure out a way for kids to record their voices. Phones are the easiest.

### CURRICULUM

<p><b>WARM UP</b> (validate existing knowledge)</p>	<p><b>Recap:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• “Just is to remind you that you are recording for a real-life podcast that can be heard by anyone in the world. It is on all major podcast platforms.</li> <li>• You will be recording your voice. We will be editing the episode for you. All you need to do is share your ideas!”</li> </ul>	<p>5 min</p>
<p><b>NEW IDEAS</b> (introduce and apply new content)</p>	<p><b>Time to Record</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• “You have 10-15 minutes to work in your small groups to record your podcast episode.”</li> </ul> <p><b>Create your own podcast recording:</b> “When you are recording, will be answering the following questions.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What is the topic you are addressing?</li> <li>• What stories do you have about this issue?</li> <li>• Why is this a challenge? Why is this a thing?</li> <li>• What is it like to deal with?</li> <li>• What is your call to action?             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ What can kids/students do about it?</li> <li>◦ What can adults do about it?</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<p>20 min</p>

### CURRICULUM

<p><b>WRAP UP</b> (gauge new learning)</p>	<p><b>Service Learning</b></p> <p>Now that you are recorded your content for the podcast, we want to share additional ways that you can contribute in a meaningful way to your community:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Volunteer at the Kids for Kids Spring Celebrations! These are events for elementary school students who are learning about philanthropy too. Your role would be to help run the events or conduct interviews with non-profit leaders who will be featured at the celebrations.</li> <li>• Identify local non-profits that address issues that matter to you.
